TUESDAY 31 October 2023

Location: Congress centre In de Driehoek, Utrecht



The aim of this conference is to give PhD students the opportunity to present and discuss their proposed, ongoing, or finished work informally with colleagues from several universities, exploring common interests and planning for future (joint) work/publications.

- Your minimum contribution has to be an abstract (400-600 words), but can also be a proposal, an extended abstract, or a paper
- All contributions will be (lightly) reviewed by you and your conference colleagues. You will be asked to review (lightly) 2 contributions of your colleagues
- All presentations will be evaluated and the best one will receive a 'Best Presentation Award'

SUGGESTED TOPICS

Contributions on any topic relevant to progress in TRAIL-research are welcome, i.e. topics within the themes: Transport & Mobility, Infrastructure & Traffic Management, and/or Logistics & Transport Organisation.



CONFERENCE FEE

- TRAIL PhD members, (associate) staff members & alumni are welcome to join the conference **for free**
- Non-TRAIL PhD-students working in the field of Transport, Infrastructure and/or Logistics are also welcome to participate; for them the conference fee is 200 euro (including lunch and dinner).
